Sales Contract

The animals of Fleece & Feather Farm, LLC are certified Animal Welfare Approved (AWA) by A Greener World, which verifies that the animals for sale meet the 200+ requirements of AWA certification. The welfare of our livestock is of the utmost importance to us. The Buyer and Seller must agree to this Sales Contract before any animal leaves the premises.

Quality Assurance:

- The Seller ensures the animals are sold as healthy, to the best of their knowledge, unless otherwise addressed. A copy of all records pertaining to the animals will be supplied to the Buyer.
- The Seller does not promise fertility of any animal sold for breeding purposes. The Seller does not promise safe and/or live births of any animal sold exposed, bred, or otherwise.
- The Seller allows for a 2 week return with full refund for any animal. Additional expenses incurred by the Buyer will not be refunded (i.e. travel, feed, board, medications, testing, etc.).
- If the Buyer requests additional testing, expenses will be paid in advance or at time of sale. Expenses may be paid directly to the veterinarian or lab chosen by the Seller.

Deposit:

- A \$100/animal non-refundable deposit will be required to hold any animal. It will be refunded if the Seller can not uphold their agreement to the Buyer.

Transport:

- Delivery of any animal may result in a travel expense to be paid by the Buyer at time of sale.
- If the Buyer requires a CVI or additional testing, expenses will be paid in advance or at time of sale. Expenses may be paid directly to the veterinarian or lab chosen by the Seller.

Welfare:

- If purchasing a single animal, the Buyer must have other animals of the same species already present on their property
- The Buyer must provide the animals their basic needs of food, water, and shelter once they leave the premises. Animals must be fed a proper diet of grass and/or hay and be supplemented with grain as needed. Adequate shelter, either a building or trees, must be accessible.
- The Buyer must ensure that livestock stocking density is not overcrowded.
- Animals must be legally allowed on Buyer's property (must be zoned agriculture or have residential exemption).
- The Buyer is aware of the three classes of chemical de-wormer used in livestock and will use any de-wormers with caution at the proper dosage and usage as instructed.
- Routine maintenance of any animal must be done so in a timely manner. All sheep must be shorn at least once per year for the welfare of the animal. Hooves must be trimmed regularly. No animal will be denied basic care or medical care.

*The Seller has the right to deny any animal sale to the Buyer if the Seller feels that the Buyer will not adhere to the Sales Contract. A full refund of the deposit will be issued.

The Seller affirms that the above information about the animals being sold is true and accurate to the best of their knowledge. The Seller agrees to the Sales Contract above.
